



## INTRODUCTION

- PMP certification is offered by the Project Management Institute (PMI) to individuals with experience, education, and competency in project management.
- It provides professional recognition, skill development, networking opportunities, and increased knowledge.
- PMP certification demonstrates project managers' adherence to international project management standards, enhancing career opportunities and earning potential.
- Preparation for PMP involves studying various project management concepts, tools, and techniques.

# PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROFESSIONAL (PMP) CERTIFICATION OVERVIEW

- Eligibility requirements include a four-year degree with at least 36 months of project management experience or a high school diploma with at least 60 months of experience.
- The PMP examination consists of 180 questions covering people, processes, and business environment.
- The PMP framework consists of five process groups: initiating, planning, execution, monitoring and controlling, and closing.
- The PMP certification is a valuable asset for project managers to lead effectively and achieve successful project outcomes.



# PMP CERTIFICATION OVERVIEW

- PMP® certification is a globally recognized credential administered by the Project Management Institute (PMI).
- It validates a project manager's ability to manage the project life cycle, apply project management knowledge, and utilize tools and techniques for project success.
- The certification signifies a professional level of expertise and a commitment to the field of project management.
- It serves as a benchmark for professionals seeking to establish their credibility and enhance their career prospects.
- PMP certification is recognized across multiple industries and sectors, making it a versatile credential that can enhance a project manager's career trajectory.
- PMP certified project managers apply formal project management processes, such as risk assessment, stakeholder engagement, and resource allocation, to navigate the complexities of a project.



# HOW TO BECOME PMP® CERTIFIED


## Eligibility Requirements:

- Candidates must meet specific educational and professional experience criteria.
- The application process includes creating a PMI account, completing the application, submitting the application, and receiving an eligibility ID.
- Preparation for the PMP® exam is crucial, utilizing resources such as the PMBOK® Guide, study groups and classes, and practice exams.
- The PMP® exam consists of 180 multiple-choice questions that assess knowledge across various domains of project management.
- The exam objectives are structured around five primary process groups and ten knowledge areas.
- The ten knowledge areas delineate the various competencies required in project management.
